

Severity

Insignificant

No Injuries, low financial loss

Minor

First aid required, on site release immediately contained, medium financial loss

Moderate

medical treatment required, on site release contained with outside assistance, high financial loss

Major

Extensive injuries, loss of production capabilities, Off site major release but no detrimental consequences, major financial loss

Catastrophic

Death, toxic release off -site, huge financial loss

Likelihood

Almost certain

The event is expected to occur in most circumstances

Likely

The event will probably occur at some time

Possible

The event is possible but not probable

Unlikely

The event could occur but is unlikely

Very rare

The event is unlikely to occur but is theoretically possible

Low Risk (1-4)

avoid injury through continuous improvement

Medium Risk (5-9)

manage by method statements / operations control / management intervention / supervision / monitoring

High Risk (10-25)

Management control at all levels is a high priority.

Manage by HS&E professional standards / HARM register / method statement / specialist knowledge / planning / supervision / monitoring
